Medicaid is a government program providing health care to low income individuals and families. Approximately 530,000 needy citizens received Medicaid coverage through the state's Health Plan.

The Department of Human Services (department) currently administers the state's Medicaid program, but this responsibility was passed to the newly formed Health Authority. Approximately \$2.6 billion of the state's expenditures were processed through the departments (MMIS) system.
